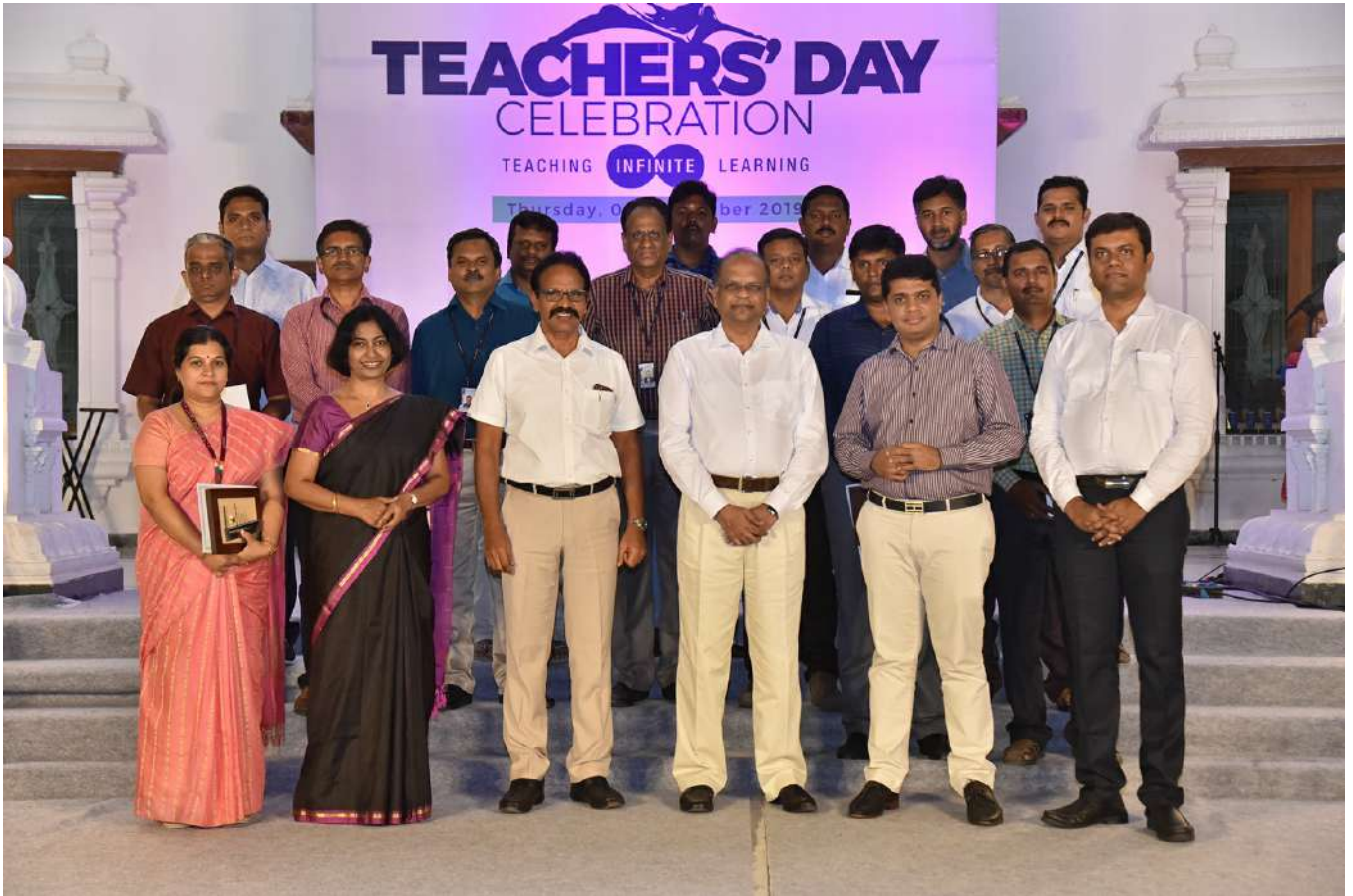
Inauguration of Ahimsa Vanam - A Tranquil Forest
